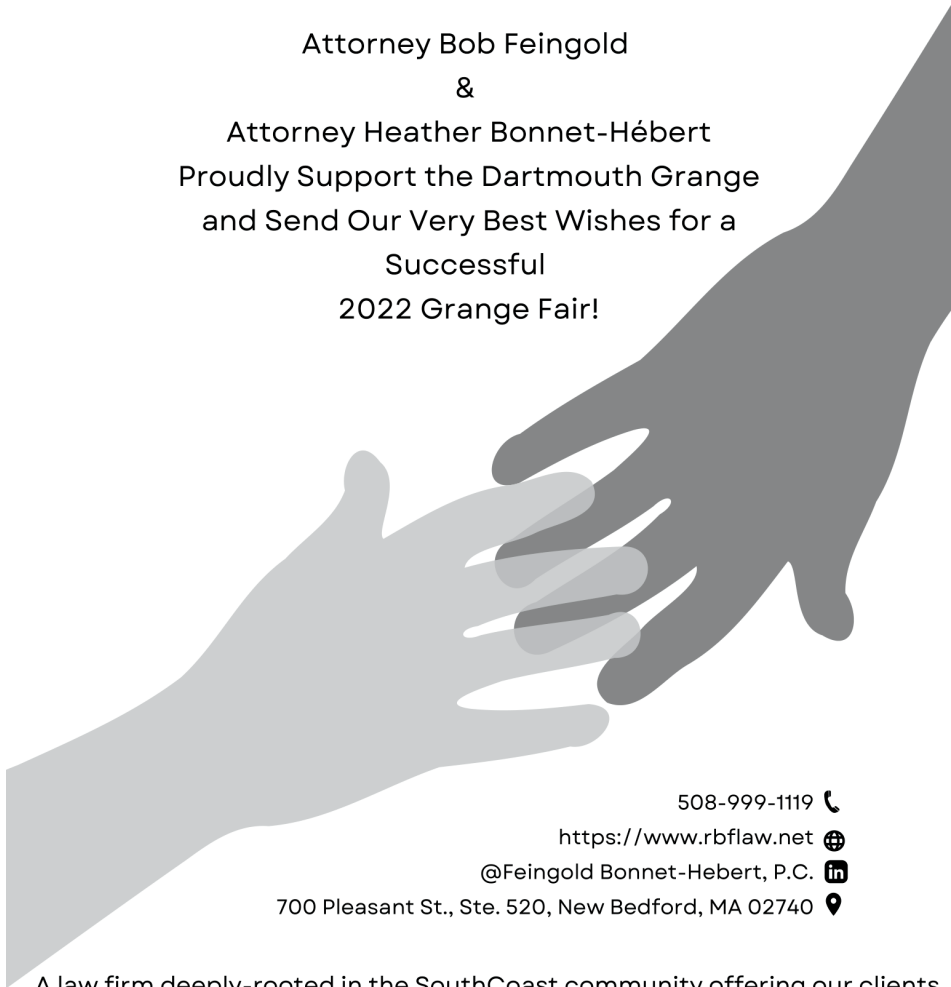

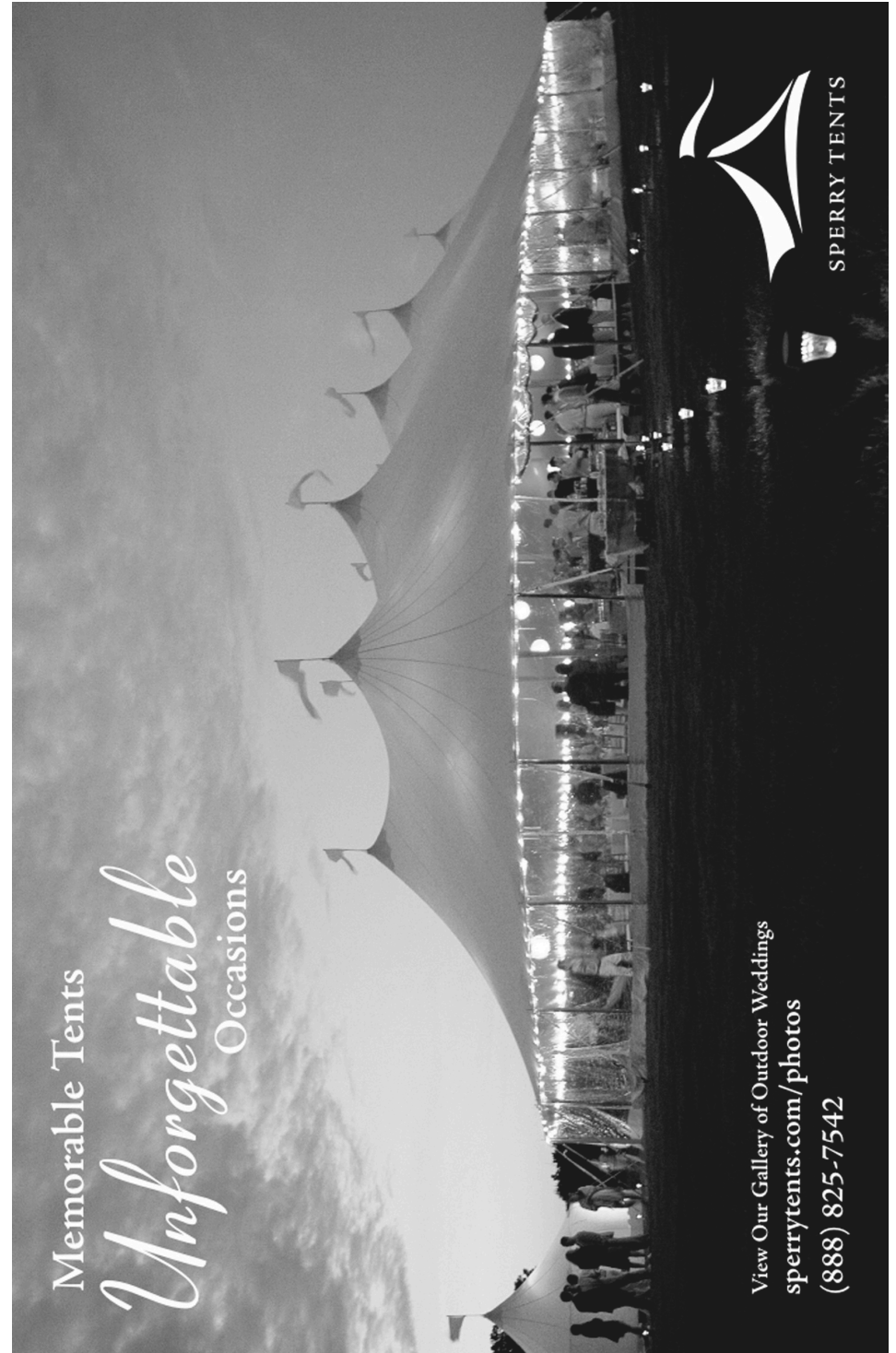

## GENERAL RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

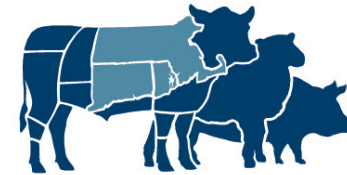
- Exhibits will be received Thursday 7-9pm and Friday 1-6:30pm and Saturday 8-9am.
- All entries must be in place ½ hour before judging begins.
- No exhibit may be removed before 5pm on the last day of the Fair.
- A person may not offer for exhibit any item not produced by him or herself. This also applies to youth exhibitors.  
Youth exhibitors age 18 years or younger as of January 1 of the current year may enter all classes.
- Placings will be awarded on the basis of the quality of the exhibit.
- The Fair is an educational activity. Positive social behavior and good sportsmanship are expected.
- All perishables not called for on the last day of the Fair, will be sold at auction and the proceeds given to the Grange.  
A person may not offer for exhibit any item entered in any previous Dartmouth Grange Fair.  
No exhibitor may compete with more than one entry in any given class.

Items for each category must be marked with the name, mailing address and phone number of the exhibitor, as well as an item description and the exhibit class on a 3x5 index card and left with each item in a manner so as the judges cannot see the name of the exhibitor. Cards will be made available at the Grange.

Premiums will be paid by check through the mail, when and if, the Fair Committee receives funds from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Agriculture or the Mass State Grange.

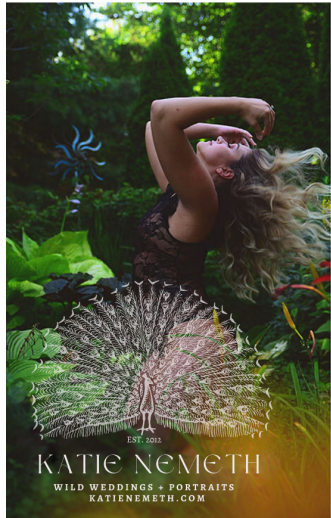

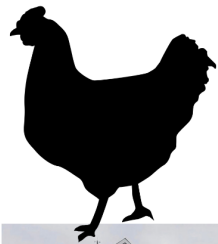

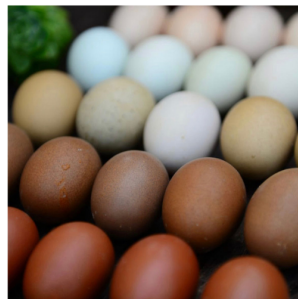
### VEGETABLES AND FRUITS

- Exact number - called for in the premium list
- Uniformity - each specimen like the other in color, shape and size
- Quality - not too large or too small, of fine texture and free from blemishes
- Cleanliness - produce washed and wiped as one would prepare for market

### FLOWERS

- Exhibits to be judged for artistic arrangement, horticultural perfection and choice of container
- Use clear containers for individual varieties of flowers; arrangements should be in appropriate container supplied by exhibitor
- Leaves should not be under the water; buds should be removed from individual specimens; wedging is permitted

### CANNED GOODS

- Produce should be of the best quality, uniform in size and of good color
- The liquid should be clear, free of sediment and the proper amount into the jar; exhibitors should be aware of head space
- The containers should be uniform, clean, properly sealed and labeled; metal rings must be removed
- All canned products, including jams and jellies, shall be sealed by processing and be of the current year's production

#### Special Dahlia Exhibit

Exhibitors are limited to one (1) entry per class; any color of dahlias may be used. Measure across bloom to determine size. All varieties should be correctly and clearly named on the entry tag (when known). Arrangement may contain foliage or filler other than dahlias, but the dahlias must dominate the display.



#### Class

- Best AA size (over 10"): single bloom, single variety, any color/type
- Best A size (8-10"): single bloom, single variety, any color and type
- Best B size (6-8"): three blooms, single variety, any color and type
- Best BB size (4-6"): three blooms, single variety, any color and type
- Best Miniature (up to 4"): three blooms, single variety, any color/type
- Best Water Lily: three blooms, single variety, any color
- Best Pompom: three blooms, single variety, any color
- Best Ball: three blooms, single variety, any color
- Best Miniature Ball: three blooms, single variety, any color
- Best Orchid: three blooms, single variety, any color
- Best Water Lily: three blooms, single variety, any color
- Best Floater: one dahlia bloom with less than a 2" stem floating in clear water in a container, with freedom of movement
- Best Arrangement of AA size (over 10") or A size (8-10"): five or more blooms, single variety, any color and type
- Best Arrangement of B size (6-8") or BB size (4-6"): seven or more blooms, single variety, any color and type
- Best Arrangement of Miniature, Pompom, Ball, Miniature Ball or other type bloom: nine or more blooms, single variety, any color
- Best Arrangement of 'Carnival Lights - Fun on the Midway': a whimsical assortment, using brightly colored dahlias, twelve or more blooms, one or more varieties, any colors or types

## THE GRANGE and it's HALL of FAMER

Oliver Hudson Kelley, one of the core Founders of the Grange, was inducted into the Agricultural Hall of Fame last fall. He joins such greats as Eli Whitney, John Deere, Thomas Jefferson and George Washington Carver, all extraordinary individuals.

In 1865 Kelley was hired by the Federal Dept. of Agriculture for a special assignment - to help with the Reconstruction process of Southern agriculture, which had been devastated by the Civil War. No easy assignment for a Northern Yankee.

It did not take Kelley long to realize that he had to find some common ground with the Southern farmers and plantation owners. Kelley's association with the Masonic Order became that common ground. By introducing himself as a fellow Mason, and not a governmental agent, he was welcomed and treated as a peer.

Kelley's trip convinced him that "politicians would never restore peace in this country." What was needed, he said, was that "The people of the North and South must know each other as members of the same great family, and all sectionalism be abolished."

His dream was a secret society of farmers, much like the Masonic Order, which would educate farmers and raise them to a better level of being. Working together harmoniously would enable farmers to take advantage of their numbers and level the playing field with buyers, suppliers, transporters and others profiting from the farm community's weakened state.

Granges were the warehouse buying clubs of the 19th century. Their influence grew into a nonpartisan political lobby that worked to create laws now known as Granger Laws - still important in anti-trust litigations today. The Grange is also credited for the Rural Free Delivery Program of the U.S Post Office and created libraries to store and share books; many of which have become the community public libraries of today.

Before cars, telephones, running water or even electricity, Grangers were fighting for the rights of citizens. At its inception in 1867, it was at the cutting edge for its time, giving women an equal vote with men even before the government granted it. Today, the Grange is not just for farmers. . . Join us!

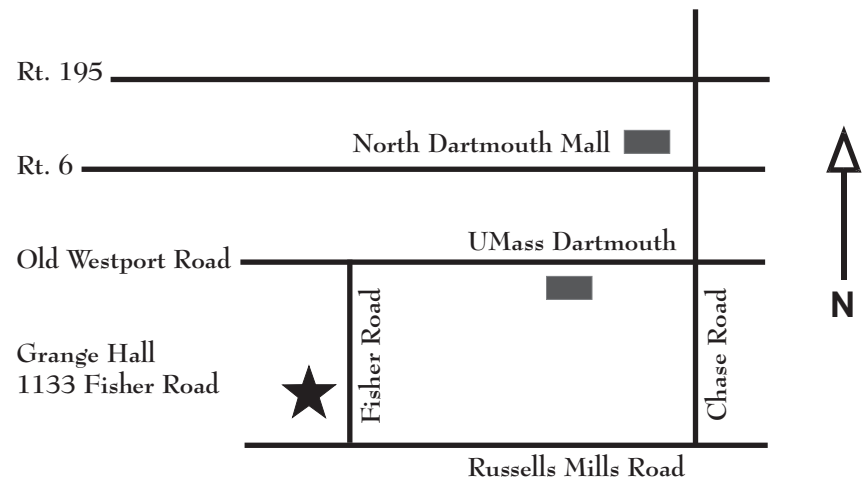
